

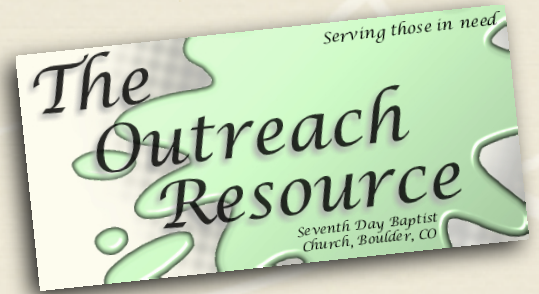
Opportunities for Whole Church Outreach

- **Pine Ridge Indian Reservation:**
Annual mission trips to minister to Native Americans through the Rez Connection ministry based in Batesland, SD. Lend a hand on the farm, feed the hungry, and give the hope of the gospel to a special people group.
- **OUR Center / Mother House:**
Bring canned and dry food stuff to Church to be distributed to OUR Center and Mother House to feed those in need.
- **Boulder Creek Festival:** Man the booth to answer questions about our church and camp program or pass out gospel tracts and Bibles. Be salt and light. Memorial Day weekend in May.
- **Street Evangelism:** Every other Sunday afternoon in Boulder, outreach on the Pearl Street Mall to the spiritually hungry. Man the table or stroll the mall to meet people and pass out gospel tracts.
- **Summer Camp Program:** Staff needed to minister to children in week-long summer camps in the foothills above Boulder. Encourage youth to give their lives to Christ or help them walk more closely with Him.
